The road from 0/0 to 3/720 is tarred road and constructed under State Head. The formation cutting has been completed in portion 3.720 to 16.900 i.e. from Dandhol to Kashapat except few portions. The PMGSY stage-II work of Metalling & Tarring is in progress and likely to be completed on 31.12.2022.</p> <p>Lalsa-Chilsa road The total length of this road is 9.500kms. This work was sanctioned under NABARD RIDF-XIII. The work of this road has been completed and road has been passed by the Road Fitness Committee on 29.10.2020.</p> <p>Deothi-Uchi road The complete name of Deothi-Uchi road is Uchi-Shah-Dofda-Dharanghatti- Deothi road and the total length of this road is 29.760 Kms. This work was sanctioned under NABARD RIDF-XXII during the year 2016-17 and up-gradation work of this road was awarded to the contractor with stipulated time</p> |
