Reply of the UnStarred Assembly Question No. 1897 asked by Sh. Rakesh Singha (Theog) regarding Cow Milk Yield:

(a) The Livestock Census is conducted in the state as per guideline of Govt. of India after every 5 years. In the final reports Tehsil-wise figures of livestock are made available to the Government. Therefore Assembly Constituency wise information is not available.

The Comparative livestock population as per the Animal Census of Tehsil Theog and Tehsil Kumarsain which fall in Theog Assembly Constituency is being given below:-
