**Reply to the Starred Assembly Question No. 4727 asked by Smt. Asha Kumari (Dalhousie) regarding Rope-ways.**

- (a) Yes, the State Government has identified following three sites for putting up ropeway in District Chamba.

<b>Sr. No.</b>	<b>Description</b>
1	Ropeway to Killar over Sach Pass
2.	ISBT Chamba to Chaugan Ropeway
3.	Bharmour to Bharmani Mata Ropeway

- (b) The latest status of Projects is given below:-

(i) **Ropeway to Killar over Sach Pass**

This ropeway starts from Bhanodi, connects Satrundi & Saach Pass and terminates at Pregraon in Killar. The length of this ropeway is 22 km. and the project cost is Rs.1618.00 Cr. The Detailed Project Report has been prepared and submitted to Ministry of Road Transport & Highway, Government of India on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2022 for approval and providing 100% funds.

(ii) **ISBT Chamba to Chaugan Ropeway**

This ropeway starts from ISBT Chamba and terminates at Chaugan in District Chamba. The length of this ropeway is 210 mt. and the project cost is Rs.15.67 Cr. The Detailed Project Report has been prepared and submitted to the Advisor Planning for taking it up with NABARD for funding of this project.

(iii) **Bharmour to Bharmani Mata Ropeway**

This ropeway connects Bharmour to Bharmani Mata Temple. The length of this ropeway is 2.21 km and the project cost is Rs.112.00 Cr. The Detailed Project Report is in final stages of preparation.

- (c) No, the requisite clearances have not been accorded yet. Once the funding is assured, the clearances will be taken up with the concerned departments.
