Information related to Starred Assembly Question No. 5056 asked by Sh. Vikramaditya Singh (Shimla Rural):-

- (a) The total length of Devidhar-Emari-Shiddal road is 5.500 km. The people have gifted their land coming in the alignment upto 3.315 Km and FCA clearance has also been received upto 3.315 Km and formation cutting has been completed upto 3.315 km. Beyond Km. 3/315 upto Km. 5/500, partly forest and private land is involved. Forest case is under preparation and gift deeds from land owners are awaited. The work can be completed only after gift deeds from private land owners and clearance under FCA is received.
- (b) This road has been constructed upto 3/315 and light vehicles are plying on this portion. However for passing of this road removal of formation deficiency including construction of retaining wall at hairpin bends is required in between Km. 2/00 to Km. 3/315. The work of geometric improvement shall be done as per availability of funds during the next financial year 2022-23 and efforts shall be made for getting this road passed.
