Question	Answer
Will the Education Minister be pleased to state:- (a) in how many schools the Government is imparting computer science classes and how many students have been enrolled, what fees is being charged from the students for these classes;	IT Education is being imparted in 1551 Government Senior Secondary Schools of the State. Total 90072 students of 9 th to 12 th classes were enrolled in IT Education subject. The Department is charging IT-Fee @ Rs. 110/- per month per student from all the categories except SC students belonging to BPL families. Only Rs.55/- is being charged from students of BPL families belonging to SC category and balance amount of Rs.55/- per month is being paid by SCs, OBCs & Minority Affairs Department, Himachal Pradesh.
(b) is any receipt provided to the students for the fee deposited by them, if not, what are the reasons for the same and how this money is utilized; and	No, but IT fee record is maintained by concerned Schools and deposited in DHE IT-Fee Account in PNB Bank, Shimla and fee collected from IT Students is being utilized to disburse the salary of outsourced IT Teachers engaged through NIELIT Shimla.
